Project Inspire Three-Day Retreats

Program Mission:

Project Inspire retreats bring together Jews from all backgrounds to learn, connect and share. These trailblazing trips offer an opportunity to experience exhilarating activities in unique locations, while simultaneously delving into in-depth Torah learning and forging close relationships.

Eligibility Requirements - If you are new to our three-day trips or have been on one prior trip, you are eligible for our upcoming trip. If you have attended two or more trips, you may still be eligible as a "Project Inspire Ambassador" (see below).

Project Inspire Ambassador - Project Inspire is a grass roots organization that encourages its members to participate in sharing our programs with fellow Jews. A Project Inspire Ambassador is someone who recruits a new participant that joins our trip and is therefore also eligible for the trip, even though they have been on two or more prior trips.

Applications for Trip* - All eligible participants should apply for the trip using the form on the website, referencing the local Project Inspire branch in your area. If you live outside our branch locations, identify yourself as "other", and we will consider your application based upon our "at-large" availability. Branches will do their utmost to make the trip available to applicants, notwithstanding space and trip criteria limitations.
