

How do I know if this trip is for me?

This trip is for growth-oriented women who are looking to deepen and broaden their Torah learning in a way that's relevant to their daily lives and connected to the experiences we will have and the people we will meet while further exploring the Land of Israel.

Does this trip make sense for me if I've never been to Israel?

Prior travel to Israel is definitely not a requirement. You are welcome to extend your visit in order to do additional sightseeing. We do plan to spend more time on "off the beaten path" experiences, rather than first time highlights.

Do I need to have prior involvement with Project Inspire?

Everyone is welcome to apply. Due to limited availability, those who are already involved with their local Project Inspire Branch, as indicated by the branch leaders, may take priority.

How do I get to Israel and back?

Once your application has been accepted, we'll send you a list of recommended flights. You'll be responsible for booking your ticket. We'll pick you up from Tel Aviv International Airport (TLV) at 11 a.m. on the first day of the trip and drop you off at the same airport by 8 p.m. after it ends.

What precautions will be taken regarding COVID-19?

We run our programs in full compliance with regulations in Israel and the United States. There is currently NO Covid testing or proof required in order to travel to Israel.

Is there any way I can get my own room?

Yes. We can book you a single-occupancy room for an additional fee of \$990. If you're interested, please indicate your request on your registration form which you will receive upon acceptance. Availability is very limited and not guaranteed, so we encourage you to apply as early as possible.

Can I upgrade my accommodations?

Yes, we have a small number of rooms available at the Inbal Hotel in Jerusalem for an additional fee of \$1800.

Can you accommodate my dietary restrictions?

We will do our best to accommodate all of your needs. Please make sure to include all dietary needs on your registration form once you have been accepted.

Can I come with friends?

Absolutely! Sharing experiences with others is at the heart of Project Inspire's mission. Please feel free to recommend the trip to people you think would enjoy becoming part of the Project Inspire Family.

What can I expect to experience on this trip?

On this trip, you will experience daily, in depth, relatable Torah learning that will be integrated into the experiences, locations and people you will connect with during this immersive Israel

experience. You'll enjoy exciting activities and meet fascinating fellow Jews, while learning with the beautiful backdrop of the holy land. You will go home with practical tools for continuing to upgrade your Jewish journey.

What are the payment terms?

- A non-refundable deposit of \$500 is due upon acceptance
- The next payment of \$1000 is due by Dec 15th
- The balance of \$850 is due by Jan 16th - at that point, all fees are non-refundable
