How do I know if this trip is for me?

We welcome Jews of all backgrounds and levels of observance. This trip is for growth-oriented people, whether you're just starting out on your Jewish journey or you're fully observant and want to share your passion for Judaism with others. You don't need prior involvement with Project Inspire, although spots are primarily given to people who live near a Project Inspire branch.

Can I come if I've already been on a Project Inspire retreat?

If you've attended a three-day retreat with us, you're more than welcome back! If you've been on two or more trips, you may still be eligible to return as a Project Inspire Ambassador. An Ambassador is a repeat participant who refers a friend who's never been on one of our retreats and attends along with them.
